On behalf of the Borough of Keyport (70 West Front Street, Keyport, NJ 07735), this office is applying for a CAFRA Individual Permit (as found at N.J.A.C. 7:7-2.2) and an In-Water Waterfront Development Individual Permit (as found at N.J.A.C. 7:7-2.4) for the replacement of the site's existing bulkhead and improvements to the existing parking lot located within Block 21.02, Lots 20, 21 & 22, within the Borough of Keyport, Monmouth County, New Jersey. Existing and proposed conditions are shown on the enclosed plans entitled, "Improvements to Fireman's Park", as prepared by CME Associates Trevor J. Taylor, P.E. & P.P, NJ License No. 44578, 1 sheet dated February 14, 2025.

Project Description

The proposed project will involve the replacement of the existing bulkhead and walkway, and proposes parking lot improvements. The bulkhead and walkway will be updated to match the improvements that were done to the bulkhead and walkway directly east of this site, stretching from the parking lot along American Legion Drive to the municipal marina. These improvements will include the installation of a new sheet pile wall which will impact intertidal-subtidal shallows. As such, this application is seeking approval under an In-water Waterfront Development Individual Permit and a CAFRA Individual Permit.
