NEW BUSINESS:

1. Correspondence regarding KBBC Light up the Bay event – Since KPD & KFA are involved there are no concerns on behalf of the KHC.
2. ML – KYC has requested a rezoning of lot 18 to General Marine & it is on the agenda for the next Borough Council mtg.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. By-laws – Kim Humphrey is reviewing with legal & hope to have them on next council agenda.
2. Dredging – Monmouth County has decided that they do not want to do the boat ramp dredging so KH is soliciting bids.
3. The floating dock was installed by DPW & all the items sent by NS for action should be completed.
4. Gary Carr of Fishing Flea Market has applied for some type of zoning & MV reinforced that the KHC would be interested in installing a camera on the Boathouse.
5. Aeromarine – awaiting answer on Aeromarine lawsuit update.
6. BRIT Account – Questions on various expenditures such as \$5700 to clean beach, Check Electric? RA to review KHC questions on BRIT with KH.
7. Kayak lockers have all been leased but not all are occupied yet.
8. Snapper Contest – NS to update donation letter & send out. KG & RA to solicit the same as in previous years. Check list will be reviewed at July meeting.
9. Funee Girl Hot Dogs, A Canoe to You & the Keyport Princess are all up & running.
10. Pump-out Boat – No update on 1 day/wk pump-out. Trevor Taylor is looking into grant program for installation of station.
11. Signage – Project is ongoing. RA is working with KH on changes.
12. Railings – AL to investigate options including POR-15. WP to investigate Powder Coating.
13. Kean University Study Group investigating impact of UB flood project on Keyport – KG/ML reports that Mike Palmisano met with Kean U rep about 2 wks ago who used an instrument with a satellite dish connected to a laptop. Every 100 ft from Broad to Walnut plotted GPS coordinates/altitudes to measure the transects on the water side of the bulkheads.
