

## Harbor Commission Meeting – June 13, 2022

Meeting was conducted in person in Council Chambers. Brought to order: 7:09PM

1. Minutes from 5/9/22. Motion to approve: BA; Second: AL. All in favor with no corrections.

### OLD BUSINESS

1. BRIT Account – Reviewed. Although the KHC understands that our commission does not have the final say on expenditures, we would appreciate being notified when a substantial purchase is to come out of the BRIT Account such as \$900+ for banners which we assume are the ones on poles along the Waterfront. **Action: BA to request guidance on when we can discontinue extra cleanings of Port a potties.**
2. Boat Ramp – Getting silted in. Are we now in a position to continue the process (ie, permits) and do we have a credit with LL Jenks? **Action: NS/RA to inquire with Jay Delaney**
3. No Wake Buoy/Zone – The No Wake Buoys are still on back order. The signs provided by the NJSP were installed at Boat Ramp, Fishing Pier, & by Matawan Creek entrance. The NJSP mooring will be installed this weekend & the Marine Police are continuing their enforcement plan.
4. Pump-out boat – The Baykeeper will be running the pump-out boat every other Sunday beginning June 5<sup>th</sup> through September 25<sup>th</sup>. WP was invited to a meeting with the Bayshore Mayors' Association, other elected officials, & the NJDEP on June 17<sup>th</sup> 11AM at the Aberdeen Community Center.
5. Boathouse – A Canoe to You is up & running. **Action: Need to have a cleanup day.**
6. License Agreements – The Borough Attorney indicates that a multi-year contract would need to go through Green Acres. The next license agreement to be reviewed is the Charter Boat.
7. Snapper Contest – KG/NS will have a separate meeting. BA made new measuring boards.
8. Dan Carroll (A Canoe To You) inquired if there was any interest in running a joint kayak fishing contest. We will invite him to a meeting to discuss.
9. By-Laws – Revisions were recommended back in Nov 2021 but not communicated to the KHC. RA will send to each of the members of the KHC.
10. Beach Cleaning – The sand needs to be sifted with a machine. Do we still have a shared service agreement with Union Beach?

1. Next meeting is Monday July 11th and it will be determined at a later date if it will be in person.
