

ORDINANCE # 1-18

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF KEYPORT, COUNTY
OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY, AMENDING CHAPTER
VII, TRAFFIC TO REFLECT CHANGES TO THE LIMITS OF
PARKING TIME ON CERTAIN STREETS

WHEREAS, the Borough of Keyport (the "**Borough**") is a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, pursuant N.J.S.A. 39:4-197, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keyport (the "**Borough Council**") have the power to adopt ordinances concerning traffic and parking within the Borough; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council hereby desire to amend Borough Code Chapter VII, "Traffic," Section 7-3, "Parking," Subsection 7-3.6, "Parking Time Limited on Certain Streets," Schedule IV – "Time Limited Parking," to reflect the following changes to Schedule IV (additions are underlined and deletions are in [brackets]):

*Business Parking Permits will be available yearly to business owners and employees to park unrestricted in the [Broad] Main Street and Division Street parking lots. Permits cannot be used for street parking. They will be processed and issued through the Borough Clerk's Office [designated Business Improvement District Corporation and then issued to the BID by the Police Department for distribution]. There will be a maximum [of 40 permits issued and a maximum]of three per business [to be awarded through a lottery in accordance with procedures chosen by the BID]. There will be a \$10.00 fee for each permit.

Violations and Penalties: Any person violating or failing to comply with any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a minimum fine of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) and a maximum fine of not more than two hundred (\$200.00) dollars.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keyport as follows:

Section 1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

Section 2. Chapter VII of the Borough Code shall be amended as follows:

*Business Parking Permits will be available yearly to business owners and employees to park unrestricted in the Main Street and Division Street parking lots. Permits cannot be used for street parking. They will be processed and issued through the Borough Clerk’s Office. There will be a maximum of three per business. There will be a \$10.00 fee for each permit.

Violations and Penalties: Any person violating or failing to comply with any of the provisions of this section shall, upon conviction thereof, be subject to a minimum fine of thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) and a maximum fine of not more than two hundred (\$200.00) dollars.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

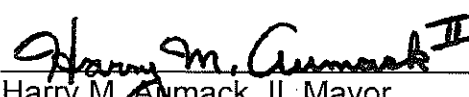
Section 4. Each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase of this ordinance is declared to be an independent section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase and the finding or holding of any such portion of this ordinance to be unconstitutional, void, or ineffective for any cause, or reason, shall not affect any other portion of this ordinance.

Section 5. The Borough Clerk is hereby directed, upon adoption of the ordinance after public hearing thereon, to publish notice of the passage thereof.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.
