

ORDINANCE #11-18

ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF KEYPORT, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER XI, RECREATIONAL FACILITIES, TO REFLECT CHANGES TO THE REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE MUNICIPAL BOAT LAUNCHING RAMP

WHEREAS, the Borough of Keyport, County of Monmouth (the "**Borough**") previously adopted various ordinances governing the use of the municipal boat launching ramp (the "**Boat Ramp**"); and

WHEREAS, the Borough will be adding a payment kiosk to the Boat Ramp, which necessitates amendment and revision to the existing regulations governing the Boat Ramp to reflect the same; and

WHEREAS, in consequence thereof, amendments to Chapter XI, Recreational Facilities, is required by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Borough Council accordingly desire to amend Chapter XI, "Recreational Facilities," of the Code to reflect new regulations pertaining to the payment kiosk, as follows (additions are underlined and deletions are in [brackets]):

11-6 MUNICIPAL BOAT LAUNCHING RAMP .

11-6.1 Use of Municipal Boat Launching Ramp Limited to Permit Holders. No person shall launch or haul out, at the municipal ramp and boat launching facility situated on the easterly side of the northerly end of Broad Street in the Borough, any boat or other *motorized* water craft of any type or design without first securing a permit therefor from the duly authorized agent of the Borough employed for that purpose or designated therefor or from the payment kiosk at the entrance to the boat ramp. (Ord. #33-92, §1)

11-6.3 Permits. All such permits shall be serially numbered for identification purposes. The serial number of each such permit shall be entered in a book for registration thereof opposite the name and address of the permit holder. Persons engaged in launching or hauling out their boats or other craft shall at all times have their permits affixed to the right side of their trailer near the jack hauling their boat or other craft visible to [upon their persons and shall exhibit them when so required by] any police officer or other duly authorized agent or employee of the Borough. (Ord #33-92, §3)

11-6.4 Permit Fee.

a. Each and every person who is an owner of the boat or boats for which they seek a permit shall pay permit fees as follows:

Daily Permit:	\$ 25.00 <u>\$20.00</u>
Annual Permit – Resident:	\$ 90.00
Annual Permit Resident Veteran:	\$ 45.00
Annual Permit – Non-Resident:	\$ 180.00
Annual Permit – Non-Resident Veteran:	\$ 90.00

Annual fees shall be for each year or part thereof. Annual permits shall expire on December 31 of each year, and must be renewed annually.

b. Annual permits must be affixed to the boat trailer and be visible to enforcement agencies

c. Daily permits must be purchased at the Kiosk at the Boat Ramp and the receipt must be prominently displayed on the driver's side dashboard of the vehicle towing the boat trailer

d. Daily permits can also be purchased at the Borough Administrator's office in advance during normal business hours. A dated placard will be provided and must be prominently displayed on the driver's side dashboard of the vehicle towing the boat trailer

e. *Exemption.* All persons who have served in the armed forces of the United States of America shall be eligible for reduced annual fee, upon presentation of proof of military service to the agency issuing the appropriate boat ramp permit on an annual basis.

f. Also, in accordance with and subject to Borough Ordinance #11-15, Section 1, any "volunteer" or "family member" as those terms are defined in Section 2-20.3 of the Borough Code, shall be exempt from the permit fees set forth in this Section 11-6.4.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keyport as follows:

Section 1. The aforementioned recitals are incorporated herein as though fully set forth at length.

Section 2. Chapter XI of the Borough Code, "Recreational Facilities", shall be amended as follows:

11-6 MUNICIPAL BOAT LAUNCHING RAMP.

11-6.1 Use of Municipal Boat Launching Ramp Limited to Permit Holders. No person shall launch or haul out, at the municipal ramp and boat launching facility situated on the easterly side of the northerly end of Broad Street in the Borough, any boat or other water craft of any type or design without first securing a permit therefor from the duly authorized agent of the Borough employed for that purpose or designated therefor or from the payment kiosk at the entrance to the boat ramp. (Ord. #33-92, §1)

11-6.3 Permits. All such permits shall be serially numbered for identification purposes. The serial number of each such permit shall be entered in a book for registration thereof opposite the name and address of the permit holder. Persons engaged in launching or hauling out their boats or other craft shall at all times have their permits affixed to the trailer hauling their boat or other craft visible to [upon their persons and shall exhibit them when so required by] any police officer or other duly authorized agent or employee of the Borough. (Ord #33-92, §3)

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Annual fees shall be for each year or part thereof. Annual permits shall expire on December 31 of each year, and must be renewed annually.

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e. *Exemption.* All persons who have served in the armed forces of the United States of America shall be eligible for reduced annual fee, upon presentation of proof of military service to the agency issuing the appropriate boat ramp permit on an annual basis. Also, in accordance with and subject to Borough Ordinance #11-15, Section 1, any "volunteer" or "family member" as those terms are defined in Section 2-20.3 of the Borough Code, shall be exempt from the permit fees set forth in this Section 11-6.4.

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Section 3. All ordinances or parts thereof inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 4. Each section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase of this ordinance is declared to be an independent section, subsection, sentence, clause and phrase and the finding or holding of any such portion of this ordinance to be unconstitutional, void, or ineffective for any cause, or reason, shall not affect any other portion of this ordinance.

Section 5. The Borough Clerk is hereby directed, upon adoption of the ordinance after public hearing thereon, to publish notice of the passage thereof.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its adoption and publication as required by law.
