RESOLUTION NO. 2026-__**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF THE SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE BOROUGH OF KEYPORT AND THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH FOR THE ITAXMAP/COLLABORATION CENTER SYSTEM FOR TAX MAP CONVERSION AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES (2026-2030)**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Keyport previously entered into a Shared Services Agreement with the County of Monmouth for the provision of the iTaxMap/Collaboration Center System for Tax Map Conversion and Maintenance Services pursuant to Resolution No. 2022-149; and

WHEREAS, the current Shared Services Agreement is set to expire, and the County of Monmouth has offered participating municipalities the opportunity to renew the agreement for the period of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2030; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the renewal Shared Services Agreement, the County of Monmouth shall bear the costs of maintaining and hosting the iTaxMap/Collaboration Center System, including the annual State recertification of the digital tax maps, and the Borough's obligations are limited to providing the equipment and internet connection necessary to utilize the system, together with any future costs mutually agreed upon by the parties.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council have determined that it is in the best interests of the Borough to continue participating in the County's iTaxMap/Collaboration Center System to ensure continued tax map conversion and maintenance services in accordance with applicable State requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Keyport, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, as follows:

1. The Borough hereby approves the renewal of the Shared Services Agreement with the County of Monmouth for the provision of the iTaxMap/Collaboration Center System for Tax Map Conversion and Maintenance Services for the period of January 1, 2026 through December 31, 2030.
2. The Mayor, Borough Administrator, and Borough Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute the renewal Shared Services Agreement and any related documents necessary to effectuate the renewal on behalf of the Borough.

WHEREAS, bids were received on July 7, 2026 for the above-mentioned Project and two (2) bids were received for the Project as follows:

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer reviewed the bids and determined that S. Brothers Inc. is the lowest responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, the Borough Engineer in his July 29, 2026 Bid Report and recommendation of Award, recommends awarding the contract for the Project Base bid items 1 through 19 inclusive, in an amount not to exceed \$214,885.00 to S. Brothers Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer of the Borough of Keyport has certified, in accordance with the Certification of Funds form, that funds for this contract is available in Acct # W-08-25-010-000-922 in the amount of \$214,885.00.

WHEREAS, the Borough of Keyport has a need to acquire a contractor for goods and services as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20 .4; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Agent has determined and certified in writing that the value of the acquisition will exceed \$17,500; and

WHEREAS, the contract is for construction management/inspection services and licensed site remediation professional (LSRP) services for Fireman's Park Bulkhead, Promenade, and Parking Lot Improvements project; and

WHEREAS, the improvements are funded in part by a grant from the NJDEP Green Acres Program, CME Associates (now Artheon) prepared and submitted a Preliminary Assessment Report in accordance with the Technical Requirements for Site Remediation (N.J.A.C. 7:26E-3.3 et seq) in accordance with the NJDEP Green Acres Program Rules (N.J.A.C. 7:36), all areas of concern are required to be addressed through construction and implementation of the project under the oversight of a Licensed Site Remediation Professional (LSRP); and

WHEREAS, Artheon has submitted a proposal indicating they will provide such goods and services for an amount not to exceed \$298,600 for construction management/inspection services and for an amount not to exceed \$49,800 for and licensed site remediation professional (LSRP) services; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Keyport Chief Financial Officer has certified funds are available to charge account W-08-25-016-000-921, Bond Ordinance #2025-16.
